- ❖ Internationally known for her scholarship on **patterns of mobility and organizational change** as it pertains to **women in the military**

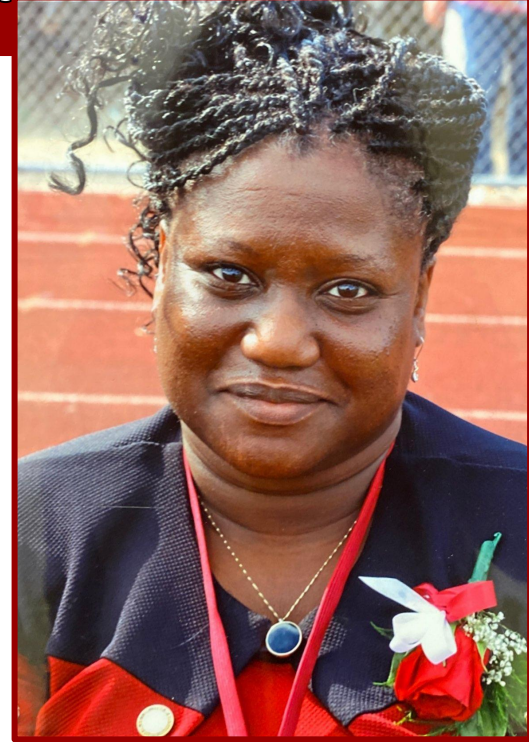

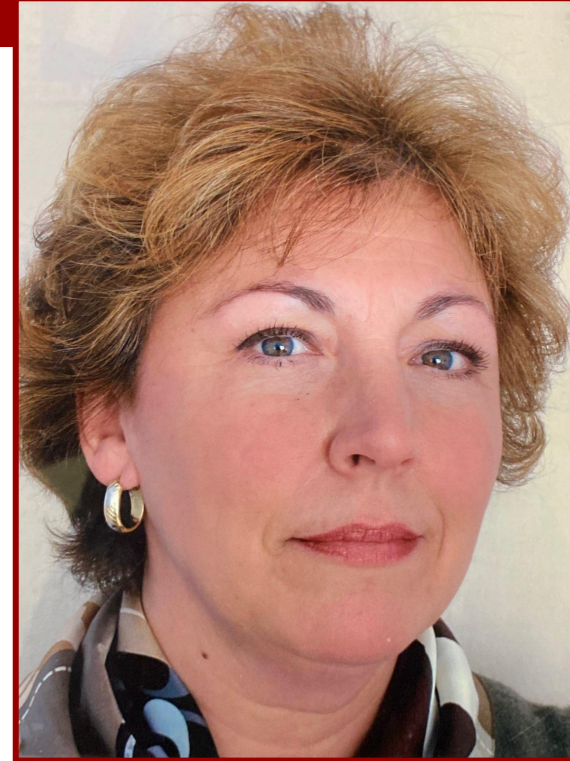

- ❖ **2015:** Recognized by the Board of Education for her advocacy and leadership as a veteran educator and school administrator in Brentwood School District

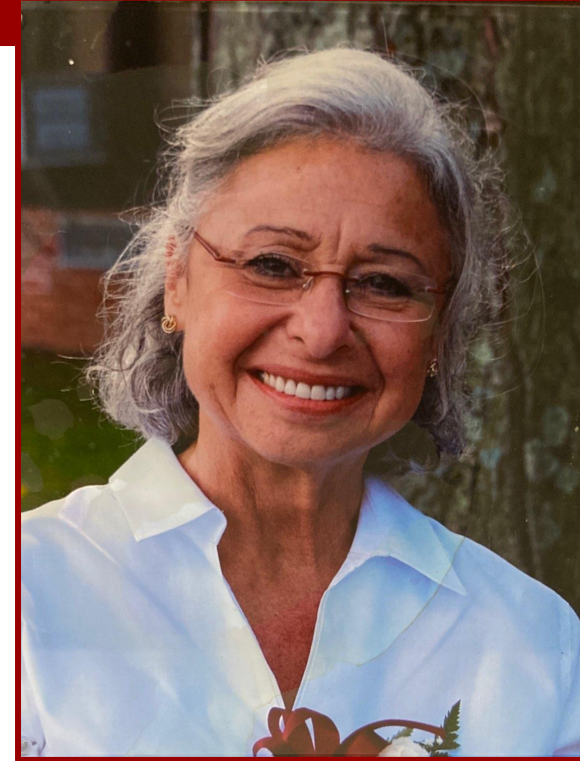

- ❖ Long-term contributions to the community have been recognized by her colleagues, neighbors, local police department, school officials, and friends

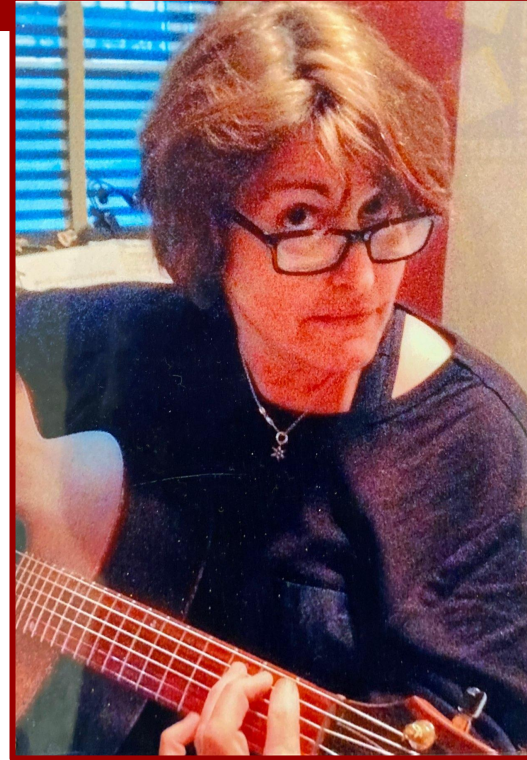
