



i-Ready Testing

Students in Grades K-8 will be taking the i-Ready Reading and Math Diagnostic Assessments beginning this week. The testing window is January 10th - February 4th. All schools will designate times for each class to take the diagnostic during the assigned testing window. The data received from this diagnostic assessment provides teachers with valuable information regarding each student's academic progress, which is used to influence and individualize instruction. Student performance on this assessment will dictate their lessons and learning while using the My Path Individualized Instructional tool. This along with classroom assignments and other benchmark assessments provide us with data from various resources that help to create an informative and well-rounded curricular path for each child.






### News from Mr. Steve Toto, Principal of Silas Wood Sixth-Grade School
