












News from Dr. Gayle Steele, Principal of Maplewood Intermediate School Happy New Year everyonal We have you all prieved a great holids



For our fifth grade parents, we are in the process of planning our Goldilocks trials. This will be a virtual event this year. The details will be provided soon.






