





On Monday, (January 11), Governor Cuomo held his State-of-the-State address, which typically contains the first prediction of school district aid runs. This is a critical step in each district's budget development because the state aid and local property tax levy comprise almost the entire district revenue base.

With that said, this year's State-of-the-State really didn't even include a hint of our potential aid, as the Governor is waiting to gauge both the federal stimulus package and regional tax revenues. While we understand the State's financial predicament, our obligation is to move forward and begin the budgeting process so we meet all required statutory deadlines. Therefore, our Board of Education meetings and planning sessions will soon turn to development of the 2021-2022 Budget, and we invite you to tune in and be part of the process.


News from School Nutrition Services

School Board Notes -A Message from the Board of Education

The following announcement was provided by the Board President at the Board of Education meeting on January 13, 2021:

At the end of the process, a candidate emerged that possessed the budgetary experience, curriculum knowledge, work ethic, moral compass and vision to meet the innumerable challenges that we face today and to build upon the substantial success of Dr. Bennardo. Though we looked near and far, the successful candidate is one of our own, Dr. Vito D'Elia. Dr. D'Elia has been with us 15 years, 13 years as Maplewood Principal, and currently as our Assistant Superintendent for Business and District Operations. As principal, Dr. D'Elia revitalized Maplewood and provided sorely lacking stability. As Assistant Superintendent for Business and District Operations, Dr. D'Elia has been a quick study and developed a mastery of the budget codes and has overseen the sale of various district properties. Dr. D'Elia brings strong leadership qualities, an unmatched knowledge of elementary curriculum, and an innate calmness that is absolutely essential to handle the challenges faced by a superintendent on a day-to-day basis.
