#### News from Assistant Superintendent for Business and District Operations Dr. Vito D'Elia

On Tuesday, January 21st, the Governor released his Executive Budget proposal. This proposed spending plan, which includes the first set of district-by-district state aid numbers, is a subject of great concern because it represents a second year in a row of historically low school aid increases to our District. We are still analyzing the impact of this aid proposal, which appears to be weighted in favor of the state's urban centers at the expense of Long Island in general, and South Huntington quite specifically. Fortunately, there is still time to correct this imbalance, as our New York State Senate and Assembly will be offering their budget proposals, which we sincerely hope represent the interests of our region. Please stay tuned, as Dr. Bennardo will be keeping us informed in enlisting community support, as we look to show our unified South Huntington front.
