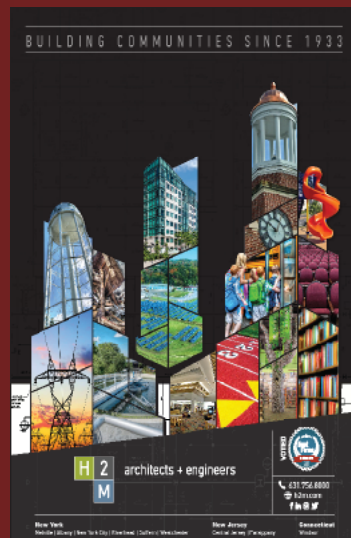

Student Scheduling Professional Development

In association with Infinite Campus, South Huntington School District has recently begun to participate in professional development focused on how the scheduling program works within Infinite Campus. This is very important as we continue to diversify and provide support to students who are academically struggling and in need. Learning more about the programs associated with Infinite Campus will allow us to provide center support and focus as we address the learning deficiencies of this pandemic. We look forward to sharing these scheduling updates with all parents as the year progresses.

i-Ready Testing - Benefits/Parent Portal

Students in Grades K-8 are continuing with the i-Ready Reading and Math Diagnostic Assessments. The testing window will close on February 4th. All schools have designated times for each class to take the diagnostic during the assigned testing window. The data received from this diagnostic assessment provides teachers with valuable information regarding each student's academic progress, which is used to influence and individualize instruction. Student performance on this assessment will dictate their lessons and learning while using the My Path Individualized Instructional tool. This along with classroom assignments and other benchmark assessments provide us with data from various resources that help to create an informative and well-rounded curricular path for each child. i-Ready results will be available on the Parent Portal after the testing window is closed. Please note that the testing window may be extended to accommodate any make-ups needed.
