

News from Assistant Superintendent for Business and District Operations Dr. Vito D'Elia

The new year ushers in our budget development process, which typically begins with the Governor's Executive Budget Proposal that serves as the baseline for New York State Aid allocations. Traditionally, the Governor has announced an aid number, which is far below the district needs, and Long Island Legislators have refused to support an overall state budget that does not include an increased allocation for suburban public schools. Unfortunately, last year's process was different in that the Governor's initial allocation and the final aid were historically low. It is our sincere hope that this year's outcome is different, and we will be energetically lobbying to promote our community's cause. We have already written our local legislators, and on January 15th, 9 am, we will be holding a press conference in the Leadership Conference Room at the JKAO building. Dr. Bennardo will be sharing the details of the public press conference as soon as they are available, and inviting our community members to join in the cause.
