News from Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum & Instruction, Dr. John Murphy & Dr. Gayle Steele
IReady Testing Grades 3-8: Why is it Important...

As part of our academic recovery plan, we continue to analyze students' academic data to help identify the specific learning needs of each student. Now that i-Ready testing is complete, it is important for us to take a close look at the results and use this data to influence classroom instruction. In support of this effort, administrators and teachers have been participating in professional development that will aid in our ability to effectively engage students in meaningful conversations about data. This will help guide teachers on the best path for supporting their students' progress. In addition, students will play an active part in planning their learning experiences.

K-5 teachers continue to participate in professional development with i-Ready Mathematics as well. We are currently in the second year of the implementation of this program. This continued support will help enhance instruction that is designed to deepen students' understanding of mathematics.

Infinite Campus Parent Portal

As we close out the first few weeks of school, we wanted to remind all parents about the importance of utilizing the parent portal to keep track of your child's grades and current academic status. At the secondary level, parents can look at their child's progress by simply logging on and reviewing the grades for each one of their classes. In addition to this, parents can also review attendance and lateness data to ensure that their son or daughter is arriving to school on time. The importance of keeping track of this information allows you to address situations before they become problematic. If you are unaware of the portal, or do not know how to access your username and password, I ask that you please contact your child's principal at your earliest convenience.
