




# Some Thoughts from Assistant Superintendent for Student Services April Poprilo

Dr. Mitchell and Mrs. Ficaro proposed a project to enhance the transition of our preschoolers to kindergarten with an English/Spanish Kindergarten Welcome Kit/Paquete de Bienvenidos a Kindergarten. This kit will be provided to students in the district's UPK program. The kits will include suggestions for parents to assist with transition, a book about transitioning to Kindergarten, and helpful information regarding the school each child will be attending, such as important contact numbers, school hours and location, and PTA information.

Our annual outdoor Halloween Parade is scheduled for Thursday, October 31st,







- 2. Just come and trick-or-treat among all of the cars with decorated trunks!


