i-Ready Testing

i-Ready testing will conclude this week for Grades K-8. Teachers and administrators will participate in Professional Development on how to use i-Ready results in conversations with students regarding their academic progress. This supports our Academic Recovery plan by giving teachers another data source for individualizing instruction to meet the needs of all our students.

Teachers are also collecting data on student's academic progress by utilizing a benchmarking system to identify the reading level of each student in their class, and administering classroom assessments in math. This along with i-Ready data, classroom observations and class assignments will help teachers identify any student that may qualify for AIS services. If your child requires either Math or Reading support, a letter will be sent home to you from your child's principal. Please reach out to your child's teacher with any
