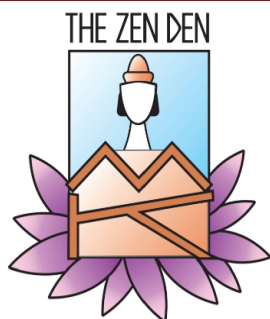

Enhanced Password Security for Infinite Campus

Over the next few weeks, we will be taking several important steps to further enhance the security of Infinite Campus passwords for our student data system.

This week we activated an Infinite Campus login alert. You will now receive an email alert anytime you log into Infinite Campus from a new device. You should only be concerned about the alert if you receive it but have not logged into Infinite Campus. In that case, please reach out to Ms. Kathy Kelsch (kkelsch@shufsd.org) immediately.

In addition, next week we will be requiring all IC users to change their passwords. We will advise you ahead of time which day this required password reset will happen.

In the coming weeks and months, we will be introducing additional security steps. In the meantime, if you receive any unusual email, especially any request for an Infinite Campus password, please do not respond to the request, and notify Ms. Kathy Kelsch immediately.

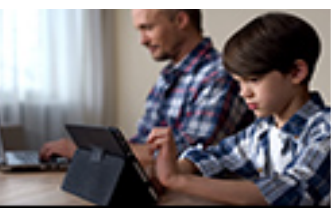

NY State Introduces New Parent Portal

Dear Parents,

The New York State Education Department (NYSED) has developed a [Parent Dashboard](#) to increase transparency and make information about school performance and other school-level data easier for parents and the public to access. The Parent Dashboard is part of [New York's Every Student Succeeds Act \(ESSA\) plan](#), which emphasizes equity in education for all students and expands measures of school accountability and student success. This new dashboard will provide parents with information about their child's school. The Parent Dashboard is now available in addition to the New York State School Report Card on NYSED's [public data site](#). The Parent Dashboard offers information on all public schools including charter schools.

In 2019, NYSED gathered feedback from parents and stakeholders to guide the work of developing the Parent Dashboard. The data elements that parents ranked highest on the survey are available on the Parent Dashboard.

NYSED is now gathering additional feedback from parents and stakeholders to guide further enhancements to the Parent Dashboard. We invite parents and other stakeholders to explore the Parent Dashboard and then provide feedback via an [online feedback survey](#) available in 17 languages. NYSED will use this feedback to identify the data that is most useful to parents and the public and to make improvements to the website.

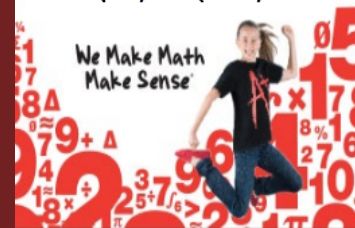

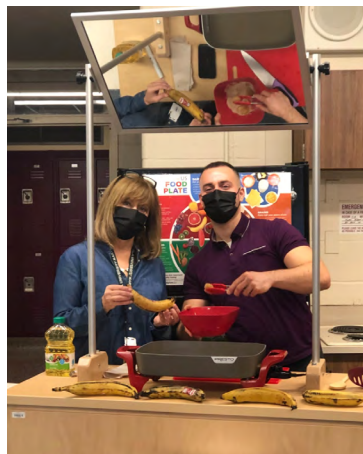

On the date of your conference(s), please use your child's South Huntington district-issued Chromebook, where you will log into your child's school Google account. The Google Meet Link/Code will be clearly posted there for video conferences within each teacher's Google Site. **It is highly recommended that you practice navigating these steps with your child prior to your scheduled meetings; students can be very helpful as they are quite familiar and comfortable with navigating through Google Meets.**
