



#### **News from Assistant Superintendent for Business** and District Operations Dr. Vito D'Elia



Whenever a new program is introduced into the District, regardless of the subject, it takes more than one set of hands to make it a success. Such was the case of South Huntington Nutrition Program's recently added **Breakfast in the Classroom** initiative last month in the Silas Wood 6th Grade Center.

After much research, it has been found that with progression from the elementary grades, student participation in the breakfast program declines dramatically. With the school day beginning earlier, there isn't enough time for the all-important breakfast meal—just one of the reasons for this decline.

Breakfast in the Classroom is an innovative way that the National School Lunch Programs throughout the country have been addressing this dilemma. This fall South Huntington decided to give it a try beginning at Silas Wood. Rather than our students going to the cafeteria for the breakfast meal, the nutrition staff brings the meal directly to the students' homerooms. Our children are able to enjoy a breakfast meal, while their homeroom teacher begins the school day without skipping a beat.

The mechanics and success of this program would never have been possible without the commitment from the Silas Wood Staff and Administration. From the initial program introduction and its first phase of the launch to where we stand today, every staff member has been positive and willing to ensure the program's success. Constructive ideas/adjustments to the roll out were presented and made. The staff came on board in all aspects to ensure the children were given the meal provided and paperwork was handled.

The SHNS department chose to initiate this pilot for Silas Wood because of the building size itself. Through this process we learned the true gift of beginning with Silas Wood was its staff members!

The Silas Wood staff put the children first with this initiative ..... and I thank them for doing just that!

Happy Thanksgiving to all of our South Huntington learning family members . . . we hope you enjoy this special time with your family and friends.


