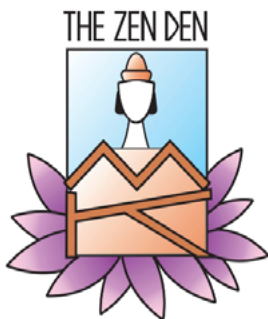

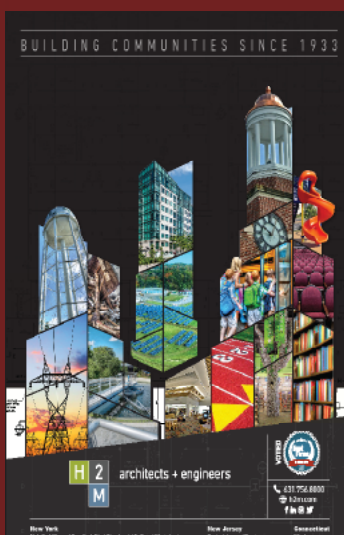

The game is scheduled for this **Friday, November 26, 2021, at 12 p.m.**, at James M. Stuart Stadium, on the campus of Hofstra University.

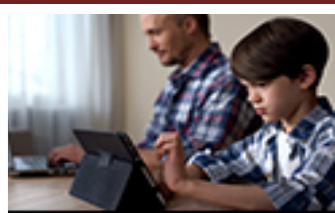

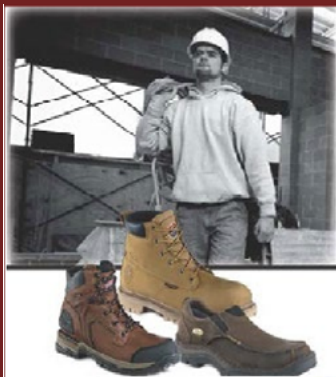

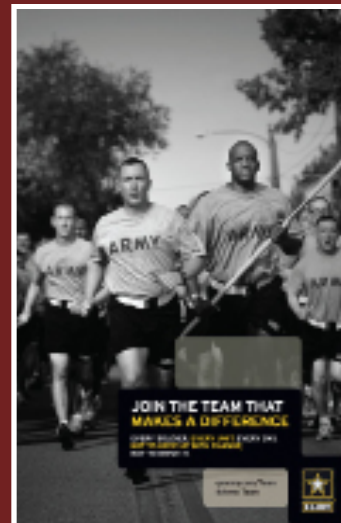
