## Some Thoughts from Assistant Superintendent for Student Services April Poprilo

The Student Services Department would like to take a moment to thank our Social Workers for all of their efforts during this holiday season. These are the unsung heroes who coordinate the countless charitable endeavors and tirelessly advocate for those in need. We are blessed to have this empathetic team in our district, and salute them for their "above and beyond work" in the community.

Student Health and Weight Status Reporting Survey - January 2020: Each year, the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) notifies a sample of public school districts to report the student weight status category and health conditions of children attending schools, i.e. Body Mass Index (BMI). BMI is a part of the required school health examination and is referenced to assess the prevalence of childhood obesity. This school year, South Huntington School District was selected to collect this information in grade levels Pre-K, K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11 from the previous school year (2018). This information will be submitted to the NYSDOH by **January 30, 2020**. No personal identifying information about individual students will be included in this survey. Parents/guardians, if you want your child's information to be excluded from the survey, then contact the school nurse by January 2, 2020. As vacation approaches, I would like to remind you that we are collecting photos of our students on vacation wearing their Birchwood Shirts or


















school colors in front of a landmark or sign. Have your child write a brief description of their location on a 3 X 5 index card and send it in with their picture.
