



News from Deputy Superintendent Dr. Joseph Centamore in the Curriculum Office

We live in a world surrounded by technology. We know that whatever field our students choose to go into as adults, their ability to succeed will increasingly hinge on understanding how technology works. But only a tiny fraction of us are learning computer science, and fewer students are studying it than a decade ago.

That's why classrooms across our district will be joining our 6th Annual Coding Celebration, "The Hour of Code," during Computer Science Week, which is December 7th – 11th. Over 100 million students worldwide have tried "The Hour of Code," and this year your child's class will participate too! Implementing "The Hour of Code" is a statement that South Huntington Schools are teaching foundational 21st Century skills and incorporating programming activities for our students. Bringing computer science activities to our students engages them in computational thinking, collaboration, and problem solving.

South Huntington's "Hour of Code" activities were developed and organized by the district's Technology Integration Coach, Mrs. D'Elia. All students in **Grades K-6**, both in-person and remote, will be able to participate in these interactive activities via their Chromebooks.

The South Huntington School District is using Chromebooks this school year, K-12. To help keep your child safer and more scholarly online, we have adopted online services provided by GoGuardian.

How are we using GoGuardian?

We have chosen GoGuardian Admin and GoGuardian Teacher services to:

- Help protect students against harmful and inappropriate online
- Help students stay scholarly and more focused when learning
- Help assess students' progress towards class assignments;
- •Facilitate communication (could be a chat feature or a Chrome book audio call) between teachers and students during in-person class time, as well as remote learning

When and how does GoGuardian operate?

GoGuardian's web-based services operate on our school's managed Google Suite for Education Chrome accounts (i.e., when a student is logged into Chrome or a Chromebook with his/her SHUFSD.org email address). South Huntington School District helps protect your child during in-person class time, as well as remote learning. To that end, when a student is logged into Chrome or a District issued Chromebook with his/her SHUFSD.org email address, all digital activity is filtered and monitored 24/7. Any suspicious activity including explicit and/or self-harm searches/sites will send alerts to administration.

South Huntington School District enables teachers to use GoGuardian Teacher with students in their in-person classes and/or remote classes only during school hours from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

What are the school's responsibilities?

The South Huntington School District selected GoGuardian services to help our students stay safer and more scholarly online. We will work with students during class time to help teach them digital responsibility and safety. Additionally, we are in the process of training all instructional staff on how to operate GoGuardian and about our policies and procedures to help protect student privacy.

What are my parental/guardian and child's responsibilities?

We ask that students use their school-managed SHUFSD Google accounts and school-managed devices for educational purposes within the boundaries of The South Huntington School District Internet Acceptable Use Policy. For more information, visit our Instructional Technology page, on The South Huntington School District website, located under the "District" tab.

When a student is off-campus, parents are responsible for supervising internet access and usage. We encourage you to discuss rules for appropriate internet usage with your child, and reinforce lessons of digital citizenship and safety with him or her. Common Sense Media is for parents/guardians and provides "digital citizenship" resources for family engagement. We also highly encourage you to report any potential cyber-bullying or other sensitive issues to your child's building administration.
