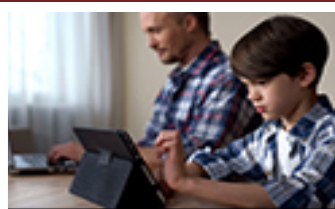

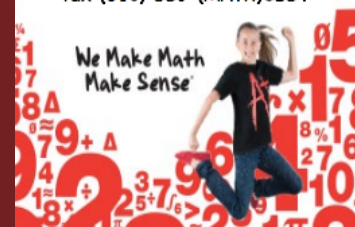


**It is never too late to Give Thanks.**

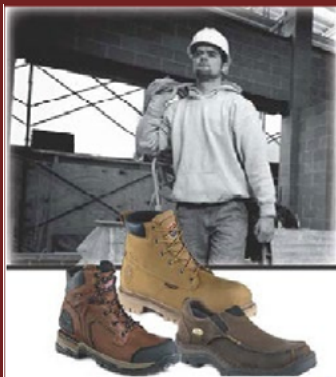

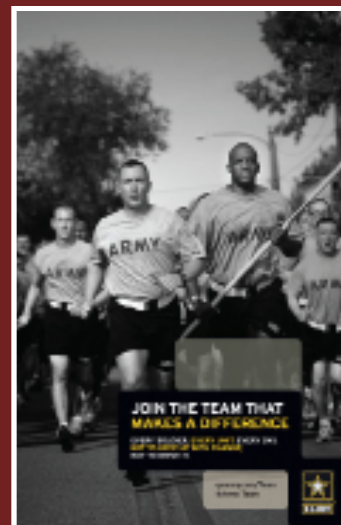
