Superintendent's Corner

Earlier this month, Governor Cuomo released his Executive Proposal, which is typically the first step of the New York State budget process. This initial spending plan represents a starting point from which local legislators typically work to increase aid to their individual school districts. The media always reacts "energetically" to the Governor's Executive Proposal, as it really does indicate the tone and tenor of the year's budget season. With that understood, we were pleased to see that our South Huntington District received approximately a 5% increase over last year's aid allotment. This initial prediction is certainly good news, especially given the fact that nearly half of Long Island schools are due to lose some degree of aid. However, it is critically important that we understand the nature of this aid as every dollar is not equal in the school finance world. School District Aid essentially falls into two categories. The first category is "expense-driven aid," which is the money a district is reimbursed for each eligible dollar that they spend. For example, South Huntington receives 54% back for every textbook that we buy. As with most things governmental, the formula can be guite complex and reimbursement takes some time. However, school districts are wise to direct spending when possible into areas eligible for the highest maximum aid. The counterpart to expense-driven aid is actually formula-based funding, which is based upon an intricate, and considerably more convoluted than necessary formula. "Formula driven aid" is determined by criteria, which provides some opportunity for NYS decision makers to individualize aid based on distinct circumstances rather than a prior year's spending. As a result, formula-driven aid, which is called "foundation aid" in New York State, is an area where NYS budget makers can exercise discretion based upon district circumstance. Unfortunately, the approximate 5% increase from this year's Executive Proposal is based entirely on reimbursements from our own previous spending. In other words, there is a freeze in Foundation Aid, which is essentially the only area where we are not simply paying ourselves back. Again, we are certainly not "looking a gift horse" in the mouth with the 5% increase, but did want to clarify matters relative to the realities of our aid.
