Congratulations to our Varsity Boys Swimming and Dive team, combined with Huntington and Harborfields High School, who won the Section XI championship for the first time in program history!


















enlightening presentation on internet safety. This provides a great opportunity to open the doors of communication about safe and appropriate internet behavior for Silas students as well as with other children in your families.
