

Round of applause for Oakwood's Teacher of the Year Andrea Lopez, who also volunteers and serves as the Oakwood Building Ambassador with SHEF.



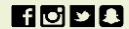

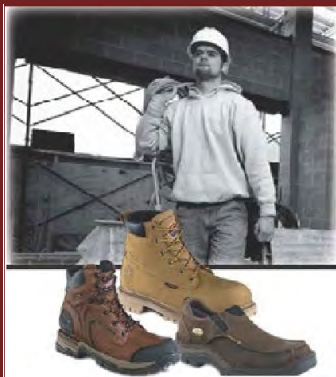

The proceeds of the sale of these properties would be used to improve the District's infrastructure and enhance the safety of our buildings.


