Superintendent's Corner

I would like to thank all those who have completed the parent guestionnaire relative to spring learning models. As mentioned in the various phone calls, the questionnaire was designed simply as an information gathering tool. The goal was to provide the building administrators with data on who might choose to return so they could accurately determine the social distance numbers. There is still a great deal for the Board of Education to consider, as we calculate social distances, monitor area infection rates, manage in-district cases, and confer with the State and County Health Departments, as well as the CDC. We will be presenting the data to the Board during the next two meetings.



Kindergarten Registration for the 2021-22 school year is happening now. Children residing in the district with birth dates ranging from December 2, 2015 through December 1, 2016 are eligible to register for the kindergarten program. The remaining dates for in-person assistance (by appointment only) located at the district office for kindergarten registration are Thursday, March 11th, (3:30 - 5:45 pm), Monday, March 15th, (5 - 7:15 pm), and Thursday, March 18th, (3:30 - 5:45 pm). We are off and running with the Fall 2 season. There are some new stipulations that parents should be aware of.

There are only TWO spectators permitted per athlete this season for all HOME games. Your child's coach will be, or already has, distributed two badges per player for entrance into the sporting event. There will also be a sticker with a specific color for your team as identification assistance for the various schools and their supervisors. For AWAY games, IF a school permits visitors, you must have your badge to attend. There may be some schools not accepting outside visitors, so please adhere to the list via a Google Doc link at the bottom of the page. There are NO AWAY indoor sport spectators permitted at ANY school in Section XI.

You may also be required to take a temperature test or fill out an attestation form for that school. Please be cooperative and respect their wishes.
