Superintendent's Corner

We wanted to update you on our ongoing practices, as well as recent developments regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19). It is important to, once again, emphasize from the outset that there is no reason for panic within our community, and the calm, contemplative approach is most effective. As with past issues of concern, our School District family will be thoughtful in our reactions, while simultaneously maintaining important vigilance.

We already have, for preventative purposes, instituted daily custodial rounds, which includes the cleaning of all common surfaces (door knobs, railings, etc.) with Virex, which is the CDC approved anti-viral solution. We have also hired additional substitute custodial staff to apply the same daily cleaning procedures to all district buses, and have learned that our contracted bus companies are doing the same thing.

We also wanted to provide important information regarding our latest communication from the Health Department. This most recent letter requires school districts to report any students or staff members returning from countries currently identified by Level 2 (Japan) or Level 3 (China, Italy, Iran, or South Korea) Travel Restrictions. Health Department officials will immediately make contact with those students or staff members, as well as their families, of course, and provide them with all relevant health information, and inform them of the 14-day self-quarantine parameters. School district officials are then required to apprise the student or staff member that they are not to return to school for the 14-day period.

Updated information on the health and travel notices can be accessed at <u>https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/notices.</u> It is strongly suggested that you pay close attention to these notices in advance of any upcoming vacations or travel. Please be reminded, as well, that the list of identified countries can change and should be referenced regularly.

Again, it is important to understand that we do not have any manifestations of the illness in our community at this point. It is also important to know that the Coronavirus will, in most cases, self-resolve. Nevertheless, we are watchful for any signs of the illness and taking any and all preventative measures to keep our community members safe and healthy.
