Superintendent's Corner

At last week's Board meeting the trustees voted unanimously to return 12th grade students to full-time instruction on Monday, March 22nd, and will measure the health-related metrics at regular intervals with consideration given to returning the junior class to full-time instruction on Monday, April 12th, with further considerations to the remaining grades at regular intervals. The Board of Education further moved that full-remote learning will remain an option with the hybrid model, subject to re-evaluation at two-week intervals, with the expectation that students are required to attend school on their in-person hybrid days. The district administrative staff will provide regular reports to the Board of Education relative to all district buildings and grade levels.

News from Deputy Superintendent Dr. Joseph Centamore in the Curriculum Office

Birchwood, Maplewood, Silas Wood and Stimson will be communicating with parents this week with regards to Grades 3 through 8 New York State Assessments. While the State is still actively trying to obtain a waiver from the Federal Government, schools must plan as though the tests will proceed, though in modified (shortened) form. The first of the assessments, the English Language Arts, is scheduled to begin on April 20th. In the communication that is forthcoming, information on the State testing will be provided and parents will be asked to indicate their intentions with regards to their child's participation. Should a waiver be approved by the Federal Government, an updated communication will be sent to parents.

News from Assistant Superintendent for Business and District Operations Dr. Vito D'Elia

At tonight's (Wednesday's) Board of Education meeting we will be presenting the next segment of our 2021-2022 Budget Development series. Our goal for this Budget Workshop is to highlight the anticipated revenues and expenditures, and provide a window into financial planning for this coming year. It does appear that federal stimulus money of some sort will help mitigate losses by backfilling local and state treasuries. The hope (actually the expectation) is that the increased Federal support will eventually manifest in the form of New York State Aid, which provides direct support to our students, staff, and programs. 












News from Dr. Gayle Steele, Principal of Maplewood Intermediate School
