



We are thrilled to report that next year's school budget has been approved by an overwhelming margin. Please know that we recognize the vote of confidence and will never take your support for granted. Our team is determined to live up to your high expectations and make the community proud in the year to come.

News from Deputy Superintendent Dr. Joseph Centamore in the Curriculum Office

At last night's Board of Education meeting, the district recognized those teachers who have successfully completed their probationary periods and have been granted tenured. We congratulate them on this exciting accomplishment and wish them well as what we anticipate will be long and wonderful careers in South Huntington.

Additionally, the district honored its 2020-2021 retirees. All of these teachers, support staff, and administrators were recognized for their many years of outstanding contribution to South Huntington's children and community. We thank them all for their dedication, as well as contributions, and wish them health and happiness in their retirement.

K-5 Summer Learning Program

This summer the district is offering a K-5 Summer Learning Program to all South Huntington students. The summer program will be offered through both in-person learning and remote learning options. The program takes place mornings, from Monday, July 12th - Tuesday, August 17th (holiday-no classes: July 19th, 20th). Transportation is available for all students in the program for this summer.

This program is designed to address the "unfinished learning" as a result of the pandemic, and is intended to reinforce basic reading skills and strategies that are essential for students to maintain during the summer as they prepare for the new school year. Math support will also be provided. This will enable students to explore mathematical concepts and literacy in mathematics.

A letter to all families has been mailed to further explain the details of the program, and should be arriving in mail boxes soon, if not already received. If you have not received the mailing, please contact your school's main office.
