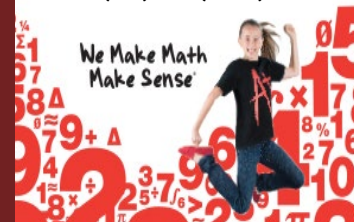

The breakfast meal will always include a fresh fruit, whole grain component and protein. We will also always have a milk choice readily available. During this timeframe our homeroom teachers will continue to handle their daily responsibilities, without interruption, as they have in the past.

We have had a very successful first week and look forward to many more!!

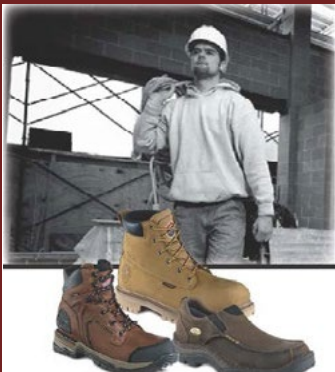
