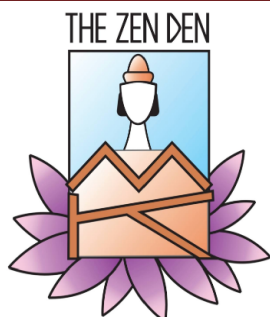



On behalf of the staff and administrators from the Office of Student Services, I want to welcome new and returning families to the 2020-21 school year. During this challenging time, we understand that transitioning back to school can be stressful for both children and adults. In an effort to identify individual students who are or may be at risk of experiencing or demonstrating social, emotional, and/or behavioral difficulties, the Student Services team members, i.e. social workers, school psychologists, and behavior specialists, developed a brief screening tool to help assist parents with accessing assistance or resources to address any social, emotional and/or behavioral concerns about their child(ren). The **Social-Emotional Wellness Screener for Students** will be sent to parents via email by early next week. In the meantime, if parents have an immediate question or concern, please call your school to contact a Student Services team member.

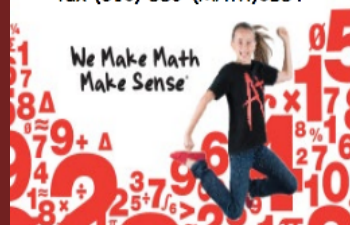

wonderful to see students and teachers interacting and moving along with the educational process. The students have been excellent with adhering to the new guidelines for school. We know this starts at home, so thank you all for your cooperation.

We have also implemented the following new procedures for our arrival and dismissal in an effort to minimize congestion and allow for social distancing:

Arrival: New signage has been added to locations at the entrance marking the drop-off point for students. In order to better manage social distancing at the front door, we are asking parents to drop students off at the entrance to the parking lot. Staff will be present in this location to assist.

Dismissal: Students taking the bus will be dismissed by grade in order to load buses from back to front. Students being picked up will be dismissed by grade at designated doors on the side of the building. Please send a note to your child's teacher indicating that your child is being picked up. If this will be a daily practice, please state that in your letter. Parents will not be allowed in the building to get passes to pick up their child. Anyone picking up a child will be asked to park and walk to the side of the building where students will be dismissed. Each grade will dismiss from a different entrance to allow for social-distancing. Signs will be posted by each exit. We ask that you be patient with us, as this is a new procedure, but it will allow us to avoid the congestion that usually occurs in the front of the building.

Thank you to the PTA for the festive Welcome Back to School sign that was on our front lawn for the first two days of school. Also, thank you to the PTA for the delicious welcome back breakfast they provided for the staff. It was a fabulous way to end the first week, and a nice reminder of the importance of the partnership between home and school. We appreciate your support and look forward to a great school year.

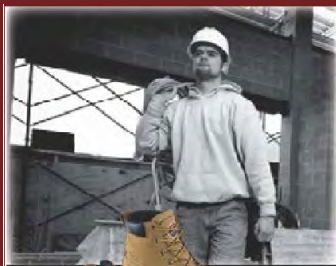

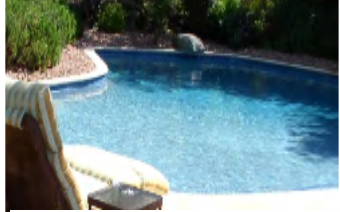


