


Our community is a true microcosm of America. This remembrance is a reminder of how South Huntington is a family; united in its pride, diversity, and commitment to the health and well-being of one another.



For those attending in-person, we will be following the CDC guidelines for social distancing, which is a minimum of 3 feet of distance between each individual. Therefore, we ask that families try to limit the number of in-person attendees to one parent/guardian per student.

Those parents who will be participating virtually will receive an email from their child's school providing the sign- on procedures. As always, if you have any questions, please contact your child's principal.

### Social/Emotional Health

South Huntington understands the challenges these past eighteen months may have created with the ability of our children to navigate through various feelings they may have experienced during distance learning. Therefore, teachers, at all grade levels, have been provided with activities, lessons, and resources to use in their classrooms that will support the social-emotional, well-being of our students. Students will have opportunities to identify, understand and manage their emotions while learning the appropriate language to help express themselves. Mental health staff will be on-hand throughout the school days, in their respective buildings, to be of assistance as needed.

### After-school and Extracurricular Activities in South Huntington

With the start of the new school year, South Huntington is focused on providing our students the ability to participate in after-school and extracurricular activities at all building levels. This may include Coding Club, Intramurals and Musical Theater at the elementary level, as well as a variety of clubs and activities at both the middle school and high school. These activities give our students time to explore ideas outside the classroom, while fostering an environment for healthy socialization with their peers. Within these school events, we will follow all Department of Health guidelines for all activities, as the health and safety of our students remains a priority. Please look for information in the weeks to come regarding these activities from your building principals.

### iReady testing in September: K-8 Grade

As we return to some normalcy within our traditional school structure, all students K-8 will take the Fall i-Ready Diagnostic within the first few weeks of school. These results, along with other classroom assessments/observations, will provide teachers with important data regarding each child's academic levels. This will help guide classroom instruction and individualized instruction as we move through the curriculum, allowing us to pinpoint student deficiencies and make sure that teachers' lessons focus on areas of need. Given that every school is different with their implementation of the i-Ready testing, additional information for each grade will be shared at the Curriculum Nights at each school.





### QUESTIONS TO ASK SO YOU CAN HELP YOURSELF


